# SOFTWARE COMPARISON AND SUBSCRIPTION PLANS GUIDE









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#### 1 CONSIDER XERO OR QUICKBOOKS - HOW DO THEY COMPARE?

- Although there are a large number of online (or cloud) accountancy software systems for SMEs to choose from within their business, we have narrowed the selection down to two specific software packages i.e. Xero and QuickBooks Online.
- However when you are trying to decide between the two accountancy software options, what are the key areas required:
  - Provides a solution for HMRC's 'Making Tax Digital' (MTD) requirements
  - Brings staff time and general administrative savings
  - Improves the ability to analyse your business activities
  - Provides easier access to your key figures and numbers
  - Provides opportunities to integrate (or link) your cloud accountancy software with other software being used in your business.
- In terms of key differences between selecting Xero in comparison to Quickbooks, the key variations are as follows:

- Xero also have some additional 'Add on' features in addition to the 'basic' subscriptions for businesses that may prefer to use native functions (included within Xero), rather than third party software.
- The 'Add on' features include the following:
  - Expense claims and mileage
  - Payroll
  - Project management
  - CIS
  - 'Transferwise' Supplier payment runs

- Quickbooks also have an additional Payroll 'Add on' feature, which is aimed at being able to manage payroll as well within the accountancy software.
- There are two levels of plan based on pension flexibility, reporting and integration options
  - Standard [£4.00 per month excl pension schemes, report options, Payroll run flexibility]
  - Advanced [£8.00 per month]



# 4 CONSIDER THE QUICKBOOKS SELF EMPLOYMENT Vs STANDARD PLANS – KEY COMPARISONS

- There is also a Quickbooks Self Employed version of the accountancy software which is specially focused on Self employed business owners (or Sole Traders).
- However our view is that it is less flexible accountancy software without the ability to allow for
  the growth of most small businesses on that platform e.g. once a business owner requires the
  assistance of an accountant, registers for VAT and/or has further complexity in Customer
  invoicing a migration to the 'standard' software will be required.
- The reasons for moving straight to Quickbooks Simple Start or Essentials included the following:
  - No ability to invite in an accountant in the Self Employed version
  - Additional functionality in the 'standard' versions means that there is some Self Employment/Self assessment functionality
  - Lack of 'Bills', Purchase orders, 'Open Banking options etc
  - Lack of VAT and MTD VAT
